A Proper Attitude

Amen. For this reason, God gave them up to vile passions...And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting (Romans 1:21-28).

When we set our minds on this world and our flesh, we are setting ourselves up for failing at the most fundamental level of how we ought to be thinking. We've all been there, done that. We've all been given over to the "futility of our minds," had our "understanding darkened" and our lives showed the consequences of it (Ephesians 4:17-18).
