David Advised Solomon To Know God

- ▶ To "know" means to have understanding of.
- ▶ How does one know God? (I John 2:3-5)
- Sadly, some choose not to know God. (Romans 1:28)
- Know that vengeance will be taken on those who do not know God. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)
- Let's all understand (i.e. know) and do the will of the Lord. (Ephesians 5:17; Revelation 22:14)



David Advised Solomon To Serve God

- To "serve God" means to give respect and obedience to God.
- ▶ God requires our service. (Deuteronomy 10:12-13)
- Serve God with a loyal heart. (I Chronicles 28:9)
- Serve God with a willing mind. (I Chronicles 28:9)
- Serve God with gladness. (Psalm 100:2)
- Serve God with reverence/godly fear. (Hebrews 12:28)
- Serve God in sincerity and truth. (Joshua 24:14)



David Informed Solomon That The Lord Searches All Hearts and Understands The Intents of The Thoughts

- ▶ The Lord searches the heart. (Jeremiah 17:10)
- ▶ The Lord looks at the heart. (I Samuel 16:7)
- ▶ The Lord weighs the heart. (Proverbs 21:2)
- The Lord knows the heart and the thoughts of men. (Psalm 44:21, 94:11)
- ▶ The Lord knows you. (Psalm 139:1; Hebrews 4:13)



David Advised Solomon To Seek God

- To "seek" has to do with making an effort to find something or someone.
- Seek the Lord and His strength. (I Chronicles 16:11)
- ▶ Those who seek the Lord understand. (Proverbs 28:5)
- ▶ Know the Lord is not far from us. (Acts 17:27)
- ▶ The Lord is found when sought. (Jeremiah 29:13)
- ▶ Seek the Lord while He may be found. (Isaiah 55:6)
- Always remember, blessed are those who diligently seek the Lord. (Psalm 119:1-2; Hebrews 11:6)



David Advised Solomon To Not Forsake God

- To "forsake" means to give up, renounce, or leave.
- ▶ Keep in mind, cursed is the man who departs from the Lord. (Jeremiah 17:5)
- The Lord will destroy those whom forsake Him. (Isaiah 1:28; Jeremiah 15:5-9; Hebrew 10:26-27)
- The Lord has promised not to forsake you, if you don't forsake Him. (Hebrews 13:5-6)
- Let's not forsake God, and may we all always abound in the work of the Lord. (I Corinthians 15:58)



What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- ▶ Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)
- Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)
- Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Matthew 10:32)
- ▶ Be baptized for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38)
- ▶ Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)
