- Must follow and abide (i.e. remain or continue) in the teachings of Jesus Christ. (John 8:31-32; 2 John 9)
- Must love the brethren. (John 13:34-35)
- Must bear fruit. (John 15:1-8)
- Must be willing to make a life-long commitment to Jesus Christ. (Luke 9:62; Revelation 2:10)

What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- Hear the word of God and keep it. (Luke 11:28)
- Believe in Jesus Christ. (Acts 8:37)
- Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)
- Confess Jesus Christ. (Matthew 10:32)
- Be baptized for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38)
- Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)
