- The fact that Christ gave some to be pastors (i.e. elders), and the example of elders being ordained in every church, being desired in every city, expresses a definite need for an eldership. (Ephesians 4:11; Acts 14:23; Titus 1:5)
- This local church is in need of elders in order to be fully organized according to the N.T. pattern. (Philippians 1:1)
- Without an eldership, this church is lacking. (Titus 1:5)
- This local church is in need of qualified men (i.e. elders) to oversee it. (Acts 20:28-31; 1 Peter 5:1-2)
- This local church needs qualified men (i.e. elders) to be examples to the flock. (1 Peter 5:3)

- This local church needs qualified men (i.e. elders) to admonish the flock. (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13)
- This local church needs qualified men who watch out for grievous wolves, and those who are able to shut the mouths of some. (Acts 20:29-31; Titus 1:9-11)
- This local church is in need of those who watch out for souls. (Hebrews 13:17)
- This local church needs those who seek after lost sheep. (Luke 15:4-7)
- This local church needs an eldership to help it grow both spiritually and numerically. (Ephesians 4:11-16)
