# This Do in Remembrance of Me

#### The "This" In "This Do In Remembrance of Me"

- The word "this" is used to identify a specific thing being indicated or experienced.
- The specific thing (or emblems) that Jesus was referring to when He instituted the Lord's Supper was that of the unleavened bread and the fruit of the vine.
  - The bread figuratively represents the body of Christ. (Matthew 26:26)
  - The cup figuratively represents the blood of Christ. (Matthew 26:27-29)
- So, the "this" in "This Do In Remembrance of Me" consist of the giving of thanks for the emblems, the distribution of the emblems, and the partaking of the emblems which represent Christ's death. (Matthew 26:26-27; 1 Corinthians 11:23-25)

#### The "Do" In "This Do In Remembrance of Me"

- The word "do" means "to perform something by an act or action."
- Simply put, the "Do" in "This Do In Remembrance of Me" denotes a command given by the Lord to partake of the emblems that He has specified. (Luke 22:19-20)
- The command to partake of the Lord's Supper is to be observed on the first day of the week, when the disciples come together. (Acts 20:7)
- This command is to be obeyed upon every first day of the week. (Acts 20:7)

### The "In Remembrance of Me" In "This Do In Remembrance of Me"

- The words "in remembrance of" imply the action of remembering someone or something.
- When Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper, and said, "This Do In Remembrance of Me" He was simply instructing the partaking of the emblems (i.e. the unleavened bread and fruit of the vine) be observed as a memorial in the remembrance of His death. (1 Corinthians 11:24-26)
- The observing of the Lord's Supper in remembrance of the Lord's death will consist of a removal of the thoughts of the world, and a focus upon the violent death of the Lord. Therefore, by doing so, one will not eat or drink of this memorial in an unworthy manner. (1 Corinthians 11:27)

## What Must I Do To Be Saved?
