- Rejoice always, and pray without ceasing, being ever thankful for all the blessings of this life that God has given thee. (Psalm 103:1-5; 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
- Rejoice always, and pray without ceasing remembering that we as Christians are instructed to always do just that. (Philippians 4:4; Colossians 4:2; 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18)
