Matthew 18:21-35

Valuable Lessons From The Parable of The Unforgiving Servant...

(Matthew 18)

- There is no set limit for forgiveness. (vv. 21-22)**
- Forgiveness involves compassion, and we must never forget what we ourselves have been forgiven from, and lack compassion for others. (vv. 23-30, 33)**
- One's unwillingness to forgive is noticed by others around them, and it causes them to become very grieved. (v. 31)**
- Unwillingness to forgive is wickedness. (vv. 32-33)**
- Those unwilling to forgive will be punished. (vv. 34-35)**
- Forgiveness must come from the heart. (v. 35)**

What Must I Do To Be Saved?

- **Hear the word of God. (Romans 10:17)**
- **Believe in Jesus Christ. (John 8:24)**
- **Repent of your sins. (Acts 17:30)**
- **Confess Jesus Christ. (Romans 10:9-10)**
- **Be baptized for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38)**
- **Remain faithful unto death. (Revelation 2:10)**
